Style of Music during Cocktails : *Do you want any style emphasized ? Irish, Italian, Classical, ...*

Music for Introductions : *Vivaldi's "Spring", Theme from "St. Elmo's Fire", Enya's "Only Time", "Rock And Roll Part II" (The Hey Song), the Chicago Bulls Theme "Sirius" by Alan Parsons, and "Let's Get Ready To Rumble/Get Ready For This" are just a few ideas.*

Introductions – *Usually starts with the Parents, then Flower Girls & Ring Bearers, Bridesmaids and Groomsmen, Maid/Matron of Honor and Best Man, and then the Bride and Groom. Grandparents and other special guests can be part of the group, usually first, or simply recognized at their tables.*

Bridesmaids and Groomsmen: *if there are more than 3 couples it might be better to provide a separate list with everyone to be introduced on it in the exact order and pairings.*

Bride and Groom: *Think about exactly how you two want to be introduced i.e. "Mr. and Mrs. Michael Smith", or Mr. and Mrs. Michael and Mary Smith", or "Mike and Mary Smith", ...*

Other Toasts/Welcomes/ Greetings/Announcements

Musical Toast: *First Request by the Bride & Groom played by the Violinist at the beginning of Dinner, preferably pre-selected, usually a romantic ballad but other selections are OK (or not at all). This is not a dance.*

Other Special Requests during Dinner – *(Mom's favorite song, Aunt Mary's Birthday, ...)*

Top 100 Request Lists on Table :Yes/No Number of Tables

How many courses during Dinner ?

Cake Cutting: *Before, During, or After Dinner ? So I can announce it. Music selection ?*

First Dance Bride and Groom: *You can dance the whole song together, or invite the Wedding Party to join you in the middle of the song, or ask everyone to join you during the song.*

Wedding Party Dance: *A separate song or part of the Bride and Groom's First Dance or not at all.*

Dance With Parents: *Can be done separately as the Bride and her Father and the Groom and his Mother or both pairs together.*

Other Special Dances: *Longest Married Couple, Family traditions, Sing-a-long.*

Bouquet Toss: *Yes/No/When ?*

Garter Toss: *Yes/No/When ?*

Garter Exchange: *Garter catcher places garter on leg of bouquet catcher. Yes/No ?*

Money Dance: *Yes/No? Traditional Polka or a collection of slow songs ? Shots ?*

Lights *Yes/No ? I have 2 sets of 4 lights*
